Note:- Apart from the schedule of fees given above, the students will be required to pay the university examination fee, Book and uniform fee hostel and mess fee separately.

According to the Fee Structure prescribed for the NRI category seats in AFRC Order No. FRC 50/25/NURSING/AMCSFNCK/PNCMAK dated 10.07.2025, the Annual Tuition Fees payable by students being admitted under the NRI category seats is Rs. 1,04,500/- per year. All other fees including special fees as detailed above of this prospectus are applicable to students admitted under the NRI category, too.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

- i. Age: The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on or before 31st December of the year of admission. Maximum age limit for the admission shall be 35 years.
- ii. Academics: The minimum educational requirements shall be the passing of Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination (12 years course), or Senior School Certificate Examination (10+2), Pre-Degree Examination (10+2), or an equivalent with 12 years schooling from a recognized board or university with Science (Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English) with minimum of 50% aggregate marks. The due concessions in the minimum percentage of marks for SC/ST candidates are as per university rules.
- iii. Candidate shall be medically fit.

HOW TO APPLY

- A. A candidate who seeks admission to the MGM Muthoot College of Nursing, College Road, Kozhencherry, under the management quota should submit an online application in the website of the college www.mgmmuthootnursingcollege.com from 05.07.2026 to 05.08.2026.
- B. Application fee of Rs.1000/- to be remitted through online payment. Application submission will be completed only after successful payment of Application fee through online.

Application fee once remitted will not be refunded in any circumstances.

Along with the application form the following should be uploaded.

1. Recent passport size photograph of candidate
2. Signature of the candidate
3. Copy of SSLC certificate
4. Mark list of qualifying examination

PREPARATION OF MERIT LIST & ALLOCATION OF SEATS (MANAGEMENT & NRI)

MGM Muthoot College of Nursing, Kozhencherry has an annual intake of 60 seats for the B. Sc. (N) course. The details about the seats are given below:

- (a) Out of 50% management seats 35% will be filled by managements from among the applications received by the Muthoot College of nursing, Kozhencherry on the basis of merit list prepared, based on the marks obtained in the qualifying examination in the core subjects as mentioned in the eligibility criteria.

- (b) Out of 50% management seats (15% of total seats) NRI seats shall be filled up from on the basis of merit list prepared, based on the marks obtained in the qualifying examination in the core subjects as mentioned in the eligibility criteria. NRI category as per G.O (MS) No.243/2014/HRFWD dated 6.08.2014 of Govt. of Kerala. **“An Applicant who depends upon his/her Father/Mother/Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins)/ Husband/Wife/Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins) of Father or Mother/Half Brother /Half Sister/Adopted Father or Adopted Mother who is working abroad” will only be eligible to apply in the NRI category seats.**

SELECTION

The Management and NRI rank lists of all applicants will be published separately on the website. The candidates will be selected only on the basis of merit. On 19.08.2026, the website will be displaying the rank list, which will be compiled based on the scores received in the qualifying exam. Online notification will be used to announce the admission date.

Resolution of tie while ranking:

In the case of a tie in the total marks, who applied first taken into account.

Candidates should bring the following documents in original for verification.

4. Plus one & plus two mark list
5. Certificate in proof of OBC/SC/ST status if applicable (Income certificate in case of e-grants students)
6. Conduct certificate
7. Transfer Certificate
8. Migration Certificate

10. Medical Fitness Certificate from a registered medical practitioner having MBBS or higher qualification
11. Eight passport size & one stamp size photo with white back ground (Passport size photo Dimension: 150 WX200H size: Below 30KB: Image type:jpeg)
12. Undertaking regarding non-involvement in ragging
13. Two sets of photocopies of documents from 1 to 8 in the list

It is the candidates' responsibility to confirm that the Kerala University of Health Sciences accepts the qualifying exam they passed as a valid credential for admission.

NRI Category

The following original documents other than mentioned above shall be submitted at the time of admission.

1. Valid Passport copy (front page & back page) with Embassy Attestation.
2. Copy of the (Green/ Visa Card /OCI Card /Employment Certificate / Resident Permit) documents of their respective sponsors. The job and validity of the sponsor should be mentioned in any of the above documents.
3. The visa of the sponsor should be valid till the closing date of admission in respect of the closing date mentioned INC and Government of Kerala. (31/12/2026)
4. NRI Certificate duly attested by the Indian Embassy.
5. Declaration of the Sponsor should be attested by the Indian Embassy.
 - (a) In case the sponsor is in other countries, the sworn affidavit shall be attested by the Indian Embassy.
 - (b) In case the sponsor is already in India, the affidavit shall be notarized by any of the notary public in a stamp paper worth Rupees. 200/-.
6. Relationship Certificate from the Village Officer/Tahasildar (*Relationship with the sponsor should comply the Government order GO(MS) No.193/2013/H&FWD dtd.22.05.2013 & KUHS Order No.2836/ACB/kuhs/2014, dated 12.06.2014). Relationship should clearly be established. In case relationship is mentioned as Niece/Cousin/Uncle/Aunt only in the space provided for in the certificate, the Village Officer should give an explanation of the relation in the certificate itself. Niece/Cousin/Uncle/Aunt should be explained with clear relationship. The relationship link should be clearly explained. Certificates showing mere/Cousin/Uncle/Aunt without establishing clear relationship link will be rejected. Candidates shall verify the certificate properly before submitting online.

N.B: All the certificates/documents required to establish NRI status shall be produced at the time of submission of application itself. The certificates produced later shall not be entertained under any circumstances.

THE CUT-OFF DATE OF ADMISSION

The deadline for applying to the nursing program will be announced by the Kerala government and KUHS.

LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

If any candidate discontinues the course, after closing of admission as notified by the authority, the candidate has to pay the full fee of the remaining course (4 yrs). The Collection of liquidated damages shall be as per the final decision of the Court of Law.

DURATION

Duration of the programme shall be four years (8 semesters). Integrated practice is incorporated with respective practical hours in each semester from semester I - VII.

Semester VIII is a period of internship intended for intensive practicum/residency posting.

MGM Muthoot College of Nursing follows the Curriculum prescribed by the Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

UNIFORM

- Students are required to wear the uniform prescribed by the College in clinical and in class room.

STUDENTS ACTIVITIES

- Participation at all college-sponsored events is a requirement of students. For nursing students, the Student Nurses Association will offer opportunities for both professional and personal growth. Facilities for both indoor and outdoor games are offered, enabling them to make innovative and efficient use of their free time. Students will be responsible for covering the entire cost of any educational travels that are scheduled during the semester.

CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE

- During lectures, students should keep quiet in the classroom, the library, and the hallways.
- Students should make every effort to take care of the college, hostel and hospital property.
- Discipline violations will result from any intentional harm done to the college, hostel, or hospital's property.
- Students are required to abide by the rules and regulations laid by the hospital, and college authorities. Violation of rules will entail disciplinary action.
- Students are required to maintain ethical and professional standards and behaviors.

- During their time in college, students are not allowed to participate in any openly religious activities on the campus.
- Students who are found to have major health problems and unable to continue the course viz., cardiac problems, epilepsy, tuberculosis, infectious skin diseases, psychiatric problems or any other major illness will have to discontinue their course and the fees paid will not be refunded.

HEALTH PROGRAMME

Every student will get a yearly physical examination. When necessary, students will receive vaccinations against infectious diseases. If they become ill while enrolled, hospital care will be provided for a fee.

HOSTEL

Hostel facilities will be provided for Girls. Rooms are provided with furniture. They should not bring any valuable jewellery. The college will not take any responsibility for loss or theft. Food will be provided in the hostel mess. The charges will be paid by the student at the end of the month. Boarding charges must be paid at the beginning of the academic year. The hostel's rules, must be read and signed by parents and student.

RAGGING

Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in the college and hostel. All the members of the college are committed to abolish ragging in their campus. Hence any student who indulges in any form of ragging will be subjected to penal actions as per provisions of law. Also the student will be expelled from the college as detailed in the law concerned.
